**Course description:** The curriculum for this course is specifically designed for women's healthcare providers and covers medications and treatments for opioid use disorder while meeting the education requirements necessary to obtain a waiver to prescribe buprenorphine. This is an 8-hour hybrid course combining 4 hours of live learning, and 4 hours of online learning. The second portion of the day will include addressing stigma and bias in the care of mothers and infants impacted by opioids and substance use disorder.

**Who should attend?** Physicians, advanced care providers and pharmacists who wish to obtain a waiver to prescribe buprenorphine in the treatment of opioid use disorders. Clinicians and healthcare team members working with providers who prescribe buprenorphine in the treatment of opioid use disorders.
